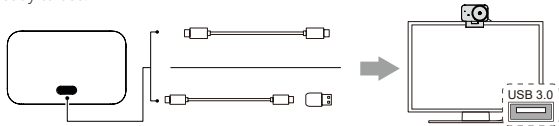
■ Mounting Instruction

Lyra supports multiple placement methods. It can be clipped onto a monitor using the magnetic base or mounted on a tripod via the 1/4" threaded hole at the bottom of the magnetic base.



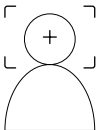
■ Connect to the Computer

Connect Lyra to the computer using the included USB-C to USB-C cable and the USB-C to USB-A adapter. Once connected, the indicator light stays on, and the device is ready to use.



Note:

- To prevent the product from malfunctioning due to insufficient power supply, please connect it directly to your computer or use a docking station with an independent power supply. The computer USB port and docking station should support USB 3.0.
- Lyra is compatible with computers running Windows and macOS systems. To avoid compatibility issues, be sure to use the included cable to connect to the computer.

■ Auto-Framing

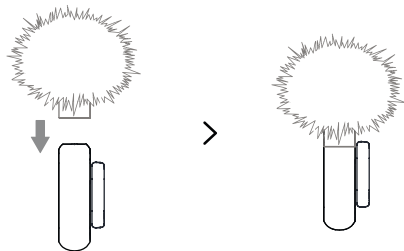
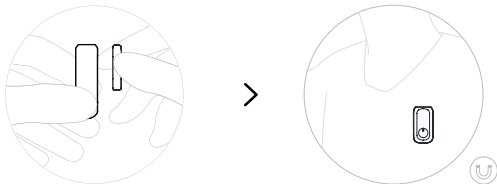
Lyra supports face recognition tracking. It can lock onto a person in the frame during all tracking movements and automatically complete the composition by adjusting the frame position and proportion.

■ Privacy Protection

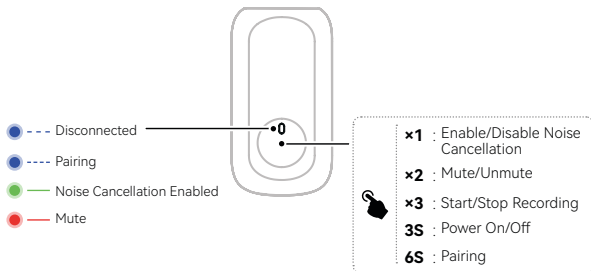
You can block the webcam by rotating the privacy shutter for enhanced personal privacy.

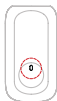
1. Wearing Method

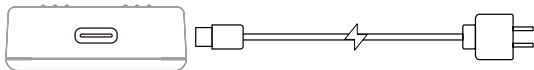
- Red dashed line: 0%-6%

- Green solid line: 95% - 100%

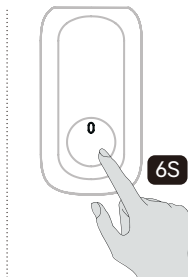
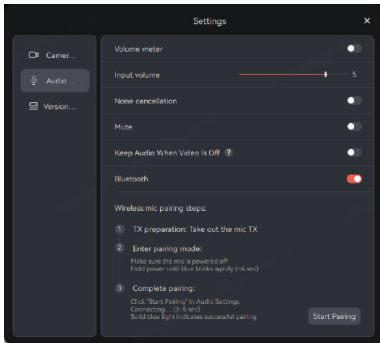
4. How to Charge

After connecting the charging dock and the USB-A to USB-C cable, you can charge the LARK A1 transmitter.



■ Connect LARK A1 TX with Lyra

1. Download our Hollyland CAM software to your computer from <https://www.hollyland.com/download>.
2. Open the Hollyland CAM software on your computer.
3. Click Audio Settings in Settings. When the LARK A1 is off, press and hold the button for 6 seconds to enter pairing mode. When the LARK A1's blue light flashes rapidly, click Start Pairing.
4. A solid blue light on the LARK A1 indicates successful pairing.
